
Push a HIDDEN CAM into the part. The arrow in the HIDDEN CAM must point toward the hole in the edge of the board.



3. A Caution

Risk of damage or injury. HIDDEN CAMS must be completely tightened. HIDDEN CAMS that are not completely tightened may loosen, and parts may separate. To completely tighten:








- Assemble your unit on a carpeted floor or on the empty carton to avoid scratching your unit or the floor.
- Push two HIDDEN CAMS (1F) into the LEFT END (B). Then, insert the metal end of a CAM DOWEL (2F) into each HIDDEN CAM.







- Slide an END MOLDING* (L) onto the notched edge of the LEFT END (B).
- Fasten a METAL BRACKET (1G) to the LEFT END (B). Use two BLACK 9/16" LARGE HEAD SCREWS (1S).




- Fasten three UNIVERSAL CABINET RAILS* (35AA) to the LEFT END (B). Use six GOLD 5/16" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (3S) through holes #1 and #3.

- Open the FURNITURE TIPPING RESTRAINT KIT (97), and fasten the SAFETY STRAP to the TOP (C). Use the provided SHORT SCREW.
- NOTE: Position the SAFETY STRAP exactly as shown.







Fasten the LEFT END (B) to the TOP (C). Tighten two HIDDEN CAMS.





Push four HIDDEN CAMS (1F) into the BACKS (F). Then, insert the metal end of a CAM DOWEL (2F) into each HIDDEN CAM.




Fasten a BACK (F) to the LEFT END (B). Use two BLACK 1-15/16" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (113S).






- Push two HIDDEN CAMS (1F) into the UPRIGHT (E). Then, insert the metal end of a CAM DOWEL (2F) into each HIDDEN CAM.
- Fasten a METAL BRACKET (1G) to the UPRIGHT (E). Use two BLACK 9/16" LARGE HEAD SCREWS (1S).






- Fasten six UNIVERSAL CABINET RAILS* (35AA) to the UPRIGHT (E). Use twelve GOLD 5/16" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (3S) through holes #1 and #3.


- Fasten the UPRIGHT (E) to the TOP (C). Tighten two HIDDEN CAMS.
- NOTE: Be sure the CAM DOWELS in the BACK (F) insert into the UPRIGHT (E).
- Push the CAM DOWELS in the remaining BACK (F) into the holes in the UPRIGHT (E).
- NOTE: The HIDDEN CAMS in the BACKS (F) will be tightened in step 18.



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


Push four HIDDEN CAMS (1F) into the BOTTOM (D). Then, insert the metal end of a CAM DOWEL (2F) into each HIDDEN CAM.






- Fasten the BOTTOM (D) to the LEFT END (B). Tighten two HIDDEN CAMS.
- Fasten the BOTTOM (D) to the UPRIGHT (E). Use two BLACK 1-15/16" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (113S).



- Push the FOOT (3E) into the hole in the BOTTOM (D).
- Slide the SKIRT* (M) completely onto the notched edge of the BOTTOM (D).

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
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Push two HIDDEN CAMS (1F) into the RIGHT END (A). Then, insert the metal end of a CAM DOWEL (2F) into each HIDDEN CAM.


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- Slide the remaining END MOLDING* (L) onto the notched edge of the RIGHT END (A).
- Fasten a METAL BRACKET (1G) to the RIGHT END (A). Use two BLACK 9/16" LARGE HEAD SCREWS (1S).




- Fasten the remaining UNIVERSAL CABINET RAILS* (35AA) to the RIGHT END (A). Use six GOLD 5/16" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (3S) through holes #1 and #3.




- Fasten the RIGHT END (A) to the TOP (C) and BOTTOM (D). Tighten four HIDDEN CAMS.
- Fasten the RIGHT END (A) to the BACK (F). Use two BLACK 1-15/16" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (113S).



Fasten the DUST RAIL (N) to the METAL BRACKETS on the ENDS (A and B) and UPRIGHT (E). Use three BLACK 9/16" LARGE HEAD SCREWS (1S).

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


- Carefully turn your unit over onto its front edges. Tighten the HIDDEN CAMS in the BACKS (F).
- Unfold the LARGE BACK (O) and lay it over your unit. Push the SAFETY STRAP through the large hole in the LARGE BACK (O).
- Turn eight BLACK 9/16" LARGE HEAD SCREWS (1S) into the bottom edge of the LARGE BACK (O) and into the BACKS (F). Do not completely tighten the SCREWS at this time.
- Then, making sure that the top edge of the LARGE BACK (O) sits slightly below the top edge of your unit, fasten the top and side edges of the LARGE BACK to your unit using the NAILS (1N).
- Now, completely tighten the SCREWS in the bottom edge of the LARGE BACK (O).
- NOTE: Be sure to tap NAILS into the holes that line up over the UPRIGHT (E).




Do <u>not</u> stand the unit upright without the BACK fastened. The unit may collapse.







- Carefully stand your unit upright in its final location against a wall. We recommend using the SAFETY STRAP for added stability.
- NOTE: Do not turn the SAFETY DRYWALL ANCHOR into a wall stud. If you prefer to fasten the SAFETY STRAP to a wall stud, go to your local hardware store for proper hardware.
- INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:
 - 1. Insert the SAFETY DRYWALL ANCHOR through the WASHER and the end of the SAFETY STRAP.
 - 2. Using a Phillips screwdriver or a hand drill, press the screw slightly onto the drywall just below the top surface of your unit so the SAFETY STRAP will not be visible.
 - 3. Apply pressure; turn the screw until a pilot hole is made and the nylon sheath slips through.
 - 4. Turn the screw until it is flush against the wall and you feel a firm resistance.
 - 5. Continue to turn until the screw starts spinning freely.
- NOTE: Before moving your unit to a different location, unscrew the SAFETY DRYWALL ANCHOR from your wall. The nylon sheath will remain behind your wall.









- Pull the SMALL DRAWER FRONT BRACKETS (8G) apart and slide them into the grooves in the SMALL DRAWER SIDES (D44 and D45 with label). You may need to gently tap them in with a hammer.
- NOTE: The DRAWER FRONT BRACKETS are marked "RH" and "LH" for easy identification.
- Fasten the SMALL LEFT DRAWER FRONT (J) to the SMALL DRAWER FRONT BRACKETS (8G). Use four BLACK 9/16" LARGE HEAD SCREWS (1S).



Slide a DRAWER BOTTOM (D974) into the grooves in the SMALL DRAWER SIDES (D44 and D45) and SMALL LEFT DRAWER FRONT (J).



- Push a HIDDEN CAM (1F) into a DRAWER BRACE (M67). Then, insert the metal end of a CAM DOWEL (2F) into the HIDDEN CAM.
- Fasten the DRAWER BRACE (M67) to the SMALL LEFT DRAWER FRONT (J). Tighten one HIDDEN CAM.




Fasten the SMALL DRAWER BACK (D166) to the SMALL DRAWER SIDES (D44 and D45) and DRAWER BRACE (M67). Use five BLACK 1-9/16" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (30S). Repeat this step using the SMALL RIGHT DRAWER FRONT (K).




Fasten the DRAWER RIGHT (35AC) to the SMALL RIGHT DRAWER SIDE (D44) and the DRAWER LEFT (35AD) to the SMALL LEFT DRAWER SIDE (D45). Use four GOLD 5/16" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (3S) through holes #1 and #2.

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
- NOTE: The glides are not intended to rotate.
- Fasten two KNOBS (199K) to the SMALL LEFT DRAWER FRONT (J). Use two BLACK 7/8" MACHINE SCREWS (37S).
- Repeat this step for the remaining SMALL DRAWER.









- Pull the LARGE DRAWER FRONT BRACKETS (9G) apart and slide them into the grooves in the LARGE DRAWER SIDES (D36 and D37). You may need to gently tap them in with a hammer.
- NOTE: The DRAWER FRONT BRACKETS are marked "RH" and "LH" for easy identification.
- Fasten the LARGE LEFT DRAWER FRONT (G) to the LARGE DRAWER FRONT BRACKETS (9G). Use four BLACK 9/16" LARGE HEAD SCREWS (1S).



Slide a DRAWER BOTTOM (D974) into the grooves in the LARGE DRAWER SIDES (D36 and D37) and LARGE LEFT DRAWER FRONT (G).



- Push a HIDDEN CAM (1F) into a DRAWER BRACE (M67). Then, insert the metal end of a CAM DOWEL (2F) into the HIDDEN CAM.
- Fasten the DRAWER BRACE (M67) to the LARGE LEFT DRAWER FRONT (G). Tighten one HIDDEN CAM.




Fasten the LARGE DRAWER BACK (D167) to the LARGE DRAWER SIDES (D36 and D37) and DRAWER BRACE (M67). Use five BLACK 1-9/16" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (30S). Repeat this step using the remaining LARGE DRAWER FRONTS (G and H).



- Fasten the DRAWER RIGHT (35AC) to the LARGE RIGHT DRAWER SIDE (D36) and the DRAWER LEFT (35AD) to the LARGE LEFT DRAWER SIDE (D37). Use four GOLD 5/16" FLAT HEAD SCREWS (3S) through holes #1 and #2.
- NOTE: The glides are <u>not</u> intended to rotate.
- Fasten two KNOBS (199K) to the LARGE LEFT DRAWER FRONT (G). Use two BLACK 7/8" MACHINE SCREWS (37S).
- Repeat this step for the remaining LARGE DRAWERS.





- To insert a drawer into your unit, tip the front of the drawer down and drop the glides on the drawer behind the glides on the unit. Lift the front of the drawer up and slide it into the unit.
- NOTE: Be sure the label on the SMALL LEFT DRAWER SIDE is in the UPPER left drawer as shown.
- Peel APPLIQUES from the APPLIQUE CARD (91P) and stick them onto each visible SCREW head.
- NOTE: Please read the back pages of the instruction booklet for important safety information.
- This completes assembly. Clean with a damp cloth. Wipe dry.
